

LATIN FLASH DRILL & LATIN VOCAB DRILL

Download Installation Instructions

Thank you for purchasing this program. I hope you find it useful in your studies. Below you will find the initial password for your licensed program, along with the instructions for installing your downloaded program files.

Initial password: **magister**

(You may change this password on the Settings page of the program.)

Find the program where it downloaded to--usually this will be either on your Desktop or in your designated Download folder. Double-click on the download (*lfd*.zip* or *lvd*.zip*) file in order to 'extract' the program folder. If asked, be sure to 'Save' or 'Extract' the program, instead of selecting 'Open' or 'Run' options. In Windows, you can often right-click on the file and choose the 'Extract All' option.

Once you have the program 'extracted', open the program folder, and start the program by double-clicking the main file with the Centaur icon (Latin ____ Drill 4).

NOTE: If you run into an error message when you try to run the program, telling you that it is from an unidentified developer, this is what you can do to continue:

Windows 8 or 10: Click on the **More Info** button, and it will give you the option to accept the downloaded program as secure for future use.

Mac OS X 10.9+: Hold the Control key ('ctrl') down when you click on the program file (or right-click on it) to get a menu, and choose 'Open', which will accept the program for future use, so that the next time you double-click on the program (and thereafter), it will allow you to open it without interruption.

Note to users of *Wheelock's Latin & Latin for the New Millenium* versions: Be sure to consider using the 'Case Sensitivity' option on the Settings page, as it will include all the macrons (long vowels, noted as CAPITAL letters) in your drilling (if your teacher requires that).
